

`Google Lens'



And here you get the answer!




Also, for any product for online shopping or any information about it, just bring Google lens over it and tap to click. All you need, will be on your screen in seconds!

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
To remember the routes, which we normally forget, open Google Map, when you start your direction navigator just click on '**Pin'** option.




That route gets saved in your history! So, no asking to anyone from next time...just go to Google maps and press on 'Go' option at the bottom.




A group counselling session organised for students of 10th and 12th, along with parents on 05 Feb 2022,
