


# TATRAKSHIKA SANDESH CGWWA HEADQUARTERS DELHI JAN 2022- MAY 2022

# **SANJEEVAN (HEALTH)**

As part of 'Self Help' initiative, Sanjeevan coordinator with CGHQ health team organised Covid vaccination drive for children of age group 15 to 18 years at CGHQ main lawn. The vaccination drive was undertaken in two phases on 12th and 13<sup>th</sup> Jan 22. During the two days camp, total 66 children got their first dose of vaccine shot. All children were given face mask and sanitizer to maintain hygiene.
