INDIAN COAST GUARD MONTHLY REPORT

INTRODUCTION

- 1. Indian Coast Guard came into existence in accordance with the Coast Guard Act, 1978 with the motto "वयम् रक्षामः" (Vayam Rakshamah) which translates from Sanskrit as "We Protect". ICG's mission is to ensure safety, security and law enforcement at sea, Search & Rescue services and Protection of the Marine Environment etc.
- 2. The month of Jun 23 has been very active with respect to maritime law enforcement and coastal security. Ensuring safety at sea was a challenge more so with the formation of the Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm 'Biporjoy', wherein ICG ensured 'Zero Causality at Sea' with its proactive preventive stance. Visits/ interactions with National/ International dignitaries were also a key highlighter for month goneby, which has been covered in this report.





MAJOR OPERATIONS

MATERIAL FOR INCLUSION IN THE MONTHLY D.O. LETTER FROM DEFENCE SECRETARY TO CABINET SECRETARY Important Policy Decisions Taken/ Major Achievements during the Month. ICG achievements during the period under review are as follows:-

A. Apprehension of IFB - 'Black Pearl'.

ICGS Mandapam and DRI team in a joint operation conducted from 30 May - 01 Jun 23, apprehended one suspected (engaged in smuggling of Gold) Indian Fishing Boat 'Black Pearl' along with 03 crew. On sighting law enforcement authorities, the crew disposed the consignment of gold overboard to avoid apprehension. Subsequently, ICG carried out diving, and recovered/seized 32.869 Kgs Gold. The estimated commercial value of the consignment was approximately ₹ 20.21 Cr.

B. Seizure of 167 kgs of Tendu Leaves off Dhanushkodi.

On 12 Jun 23, ICG Mandapam received input from local fishermen regarding sighting of some gunny bags washed ashore south of Dhanushkodi off Arichalmunai. On reaching the site, ICG team in co-ordination with Custom recovered 17 gunny bags containing Tendu Leaves. The whole consignment was handed over to Customs Dept, Rameshwaram for further necessary action. The estimated commercial value of the consignment was approximately ₹11.92 Lakhs.

MAJOR OPERATIONS

C. Rescue of 50 Stranded Persons - 'Cyclone - Biparjoy'.

Consequent to issuance of warning by IMD regarding Very Severe Cyclonic Storm 'BIPARJOY' formed in Arabian Sea from 06 Jun 23, ICG initiated various proactive & preventive measures to ensure safety of fishers and mariners at sea. ICG ships and aircraft were deployed in Gujarat, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Kerala, Goa and Daman coasts to broadcast warning on VHF and to advise fishermen, if any at sea to return harbour. Further, ICG assets also alerted merchant vessels of impending weather conditions. Necessary liaison was maintained with all other stakeholders including coastal states, port authorities, and fisheries. All concerned were advised/ apprised to undertake necessary precautions. 48 ICG Disaster Response Teams (DRTs) with Gemini (Lifeboat) and Life Saving Equipment/ Response Gears were also kept standby. ICG DRTs assisted local administration in restoration work. The Very Severe Cyclonic Storm gradually moved north-eastwards and gradually intensified into an Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm (ESCS), also re-curved towards Gujarat coast. Accordingly, various preparedness meetings were conducted by central / state authorities.

On 12 Jun 23, during NCMC meeting, the Cabinet Secretary (Cab-Sec) reviewed the situation and directed responsible agency towards immediate evacuation of crew (50 nos) from the oil rig 'Key Singapore/01'. Consequently, the Secretary, MoPS&W directed relevant authorities for immediate compliance. Accordingly, Directorate General of Hydrocarbons (DGH) had requested Indian Coast Guard (ICG) for immediate evacuation of all crew. ICG ship Shoor in area was diverted to the jack up rig position.

Additionally, ICG helo ALH Mk III (CG 858) positioned at Rajkot for cyclone shelter was also tasked to Okha for evacuation of crew. Despite challenging and inclement weather conditions (Sea state 6-7, Winds 80-100 Kmph, Poor visibility, Low clouds & Incessant rain), ALH MK III CG 858 was tasked for evacuation. All stranded crew (50 numbers) from jack up rig 'Key Singapore' were evacuated to safety ashore by utilising only one ICG ALH MK III. The pre-emptive/ proactive efforts by ICG in coordination with State and Port authorities resulted in nil loss of life and property at sea.

D. Seizure of 1137 kgs unprocessed Sea Cucumber off Mandapam.

Based on specific inputs, ICG carried out operation to nab suspects involved in smuggling of sea cucumbers on 22 Jun 23. The team observed suspicious movement of few persons with gunny bags on the Vedalai shore. On sighting ICG team, the suspects left gunny bags into the water and fled the scene taking advantage of darkness. Accordingly, 67 gunny bags containing raw Sea Cucumber were seized from the spot. The consignment was then handed over to Forest department for further necessary action. The estimated commercial value of the consignment is approximately ₹5.11 Cr.

SEARCH & RESCUE

A. SAR Efforts for Indian Fishing Boat - 'Rosanna'.

On 27 May 23, MRCC Mumbai received an email from MV Navdhenu Sun regarding IFB 'Rosanna' with 09 crew stranded 78 nautical mile South-West of Diu Head due to engine failure. ICG Ship Shoor was diverted to investigate and provide necessary assistance to stranded IFB. On arriving at scene, the stranded IFB was taken under tow to Veraval. IFB Rosanna was then handed over to another fishing boat Bhawani Kripa off Veraval, entered Veraval harbour safely. The timely assistance by ICG saved nine (09) precious lives.

B. SAR Efforts for Distressed Indian Fishing Boat -'Thalapathy'.

On 28 May 23, MRSC Mandapam received an information from AD Fisheries, Mandapam regarding distress onboard IFB 'Thalapathy' off Pamban. The said IFB reported to be drifting towards Indo-Sri Lanka IMBL. On receipt of information, ICGS C-432 on area patrol was diverted for rendering assistance. The ICG ship arrived the datum and located distressed IFB. The IFB (with 06 crew) was taken undertow to Mandapam, and handed over to Fisheries, Mandapam. The timely assistance by ICG saved six (06) precious lives.

C. Medical Evacuation of Patients at Male (Maldives).

On 28 May 23, MNDF requested medical evacuation of patients namely Mr. Mohamed Alsan Ahmed, age- 19 yrs and Mr. Ibrahim Zain, age-18 yrs (both Maldivian national) diagnosed with unspecified head injury owing to road accident. The patients were evacuated from Fuvahmulah to Malé for further medical management at IGM Hospital, Male.

D. Medical Evacuation of patients at Male (Maldives).

On 04 Jun 23, MNDF requested medical evacuation of a 23 years old Maldivian national (Mr. Ahmed Faaidh Ali) diagnosed with Rt temper parietal epidural hematoma with undisclosed fracture of Rt squamous temporal and parietal bone. The patient was evacuated from Gan (VRMG) to Malé (VRMM), for treatment by medical specialist at IGM Hospital, Malé.

On 07 Jun 23, MNDF requested medical evacuation of a 34 years old Maldivian national (Mr. Ahmed Aslam) diagnosed with unspecified head injury. The patient was evacuated from Fuvahmulah (VRMR) to Malé (VRMM), for treatment by medical specialist at IGMH, Malé.







Cyclone Biparjoy set to hit Kutch

On Sunday, Gujarat Chief Minister Bhupendra Pael held a review meeting with district officials. He directed the administration to deploy the National Disaster Response Force (SDRF) and State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) teams, and take other precautionary measures in the Kutch, Jamangar, Morbs, Gir Somnath, Fortbandar, and Devblumi by the cyclone. 
