3. All other entries will remain unchanged.
4. This corrigendum is issued to include reservation for EWS category post-notification of GoI, DoP&T OM No. 36039/1/2019-Estt(Res) dated 31 Jan 19. Candidates from EWS category fulfilling conditions laid down in OM ibid and who have applied in response to the earlier advertisement dated 23 Feb-01 Mar 19 need not apply again. They will be considered on production of requisite documents at the time of recruitment/written examination. Candidates of EWS category who have not submitted their applications earlier may submit their applications alongwith proof of documents within 30 days from the date of publication of this corrigendum. Last date for receipt of applications from other than EWS candidates has been closed, hence, fresh applications from them will not be accepted.
5. The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The Income and Asset certificate to be produced by Economically Weaker Sections by the following authorities in the prescribed format shall only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as belonging to EWS:-

(i) District Magistrate/ Additional District Magistrate/ Collector/ Deputy Commissioner/ Additional Deputy Commissioner/ 1st Class Stipendary Magistrate/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate/ Taluka Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate/ Extra Assistant Commissioner

(ii) Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate

(iii) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar and

(iv) Sub-Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.
