PREAMBLE

- 1. This contract is made on this day, 5TH day of the Month of December 2017 in New Delhi, between the President of India are presented by the Principal Director (Logistics), Coast Guard Headquarters, Ministry of Defence, Government of India, South Block, New Delhi herein after referred to as the 'Buyer' (which term, unless excluded by the context, shall be deemed to includehis successor in office) on one part, and M/s Okaya Power Pvt. Ltd. and incorporated under thelaws of India, having its registered office at New Delhi (which term, unless expressly excluded by the context, shall be deemed to include its successors and assignees), hereinafter referred to as the Seller' on the other part.
- 2. The Seller undertakes to sell and deliver to the Buyer, and the Buyer undertakes to accept and pay for on the terms & conditions stipulated in this contract, the items/services, quantity, unit price and total value as specified in Part-II of this contract.
- 3. This Contract is divided into five parts. The Buyer and Seller agree forthe following as mentioned in other four parts of this contract
 - a. Part II -. Buyer agrees to buy and Seller agrees to sell items/services mentioned in Part II at the prices mentioned therein. Part III - Standard Conditions of Contract

- 1. <u>Law</u>: The Contract shall be considered and made in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India. The contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India.
- 2. <u>Effective Date of the Contract</u>: The contract shall come into effect on the date of signatures of both the parties on the contract (Effective Date) and shall remain valid for **two years extendable to additional one year**. Thedeliveries and supplies and performance of the services shall commence from the effective date of the contract.
- 3. <u>Arbitration</u>: All disputes or differences arising out of or in connection with the Contract shall be settled by bilateral discussions. Any dispute, disagreement or question arising out of or relating to the Contract or relating to construction or performance, which cannot be settled amicably, may be resolved through arbitration. The Arbitration is as per Form DPM-7 / DPM-8 / DPM-9 enclosed to Part-III of this contract.
- Penalty for use of Undue influence: The Seller undertakes that he has not given, offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly, any gift, consideration, reward, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any person in service ofthe Buyer or otherwise in procuring the Contracts or forbearing to do or for having done or forborne to do any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of the present Contract or any other Contract with the Government of India for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavour to any person in relation to the present Contract or any other Contract with the Government of India. Any breach of the aforesaid undertaking by the Seller or any one employed by him or acting on hisbehalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the Seller) or the commission ofany offers by the Seller or anyone employed by him or acting on his behalf, as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1986 or any other Act enacted for the prevention of corruption shall entitle the Buyer to cancel the contract and all or any other contracts with the Seller and recover from the Seller the amount of any loss arising from such cancellation. A decision of the Buyer or his nominee to the effect that a breach of the undertaking had been committed shall be final and binding on the Seller. Giving or offering of any gift, bribe or inducement or any attempt at any such acton behalf of the Seller towards any officer/employee of the Buyer or to any other person in a position to influence any officer/employee of the Buyer for showing any favour in relation to this or any other contract, shall render the Seller to such liability/ penalty as the Buyer may deem proper, including but not limited to termination of the contract, imposition of penal damages, forfeiture of the Bank Guarantee and refund of the amounts paid by the Buyer.
- 5. Agents / Agency Commission: The Seller confirms and declares to the Buyer that the Seller is the original manufacturer of the stores/provider of the services referred to in this Contract and has not engaged any individual or firm, whether Indian or foreign whatsoever, to intercede, facilitate or in any way to recommend to the Government of India or any of its functionaries, whether officially or unofficially, to the award of the contract to the Seller; nor has any amount been paid, promised or intended to be paid to any such individual or firm in respect of any such intercession, facilitation or recommendation. The Seller agrees that if itis established at any time to the satisfaction of the Buyer that the present declaration is in any way incorrect or if at a later stage it is

The Seller will also be debarred from entering into any supply Contract with the Government ofIndia for a minimum period of five years. The Buyer will also have a right toconsider cancellation of the Contract either wholly or in part, without any entitlement or compensation to the Seller who shall in such anevent be liable torefund all payments made by the Buyer in terms of the Contract along with interest at the rate of 2% per annum above LIBOR rate. The Buyer will also have the right to recover any such amount from any contracts concluded earlier with the Government of India.

- 6. Access to books of Accounts: In case it is found to the satisfaction of the Buyer that the Seller has engaged an Agent or paid commission or influenced any person to obtain the contract as described in clauses relating to Agents/Agency Commission and penalty for use of undue influence, the Seller, on a specific request of the Buyer, shall provide necessary information/ inspection of the relevant financial documents/information.
- 7. **Non-disclosure of Contract documents**: Except with the written consent of the Buyer/Seller, other party shall not disclose the contract or any provision, specification, plan, design, pattern, sample or information thereof to any third party.
- 8. <u>Liquidated Damages</u>: In the event of the Seller's failure to submit the Bonds, Guarantees and Documents, supply the stores/goods and conduct trials, installation of equipment, training, etc as specified in this contract, the Buyer may, at his discretion, withhold any payment until the completion of the contract. The Buyer may also deduct from the Seller as agreed, Liquidated Damages to the sumof 0.5% of the contract price of the delayed/undelivered stores/services mentioned above for every week of delay or part of a week, subject to the maximum value ofthe Liquidated Damages being not higher than 10% of the value of delayed stores.
- 9. <u>Termination of the contract</u>: The Buyer shall have the right to terminate this Contract in part or in full in any of the following cases:-
 - (a) The delivery of the material is delayed for causes not attributable to Force Majeure for more than **06 months** after the scheduled date of delivery.
 - (b) The Seller is declared bankrupt or becomes insolvent.
 - (c) The delivery of material is delayed due to causes of Force Majeure by more than **12 months**.
 - (d) The Buyer has noticed that the Seller has utilised the services of anylndian/Foreign agent in getting this contract and paid any commission to such individual/company etc.
 - (e) As per decision of the Arbitration Tribunal,

The Seller shall be responsible forthe completion of the supplies including spares, tools, technical literature and training aggregates irrespective of the fact of infringement of the supplies, irrespective of the fact of infringement of any or all the rights mentioned above.
- 13. <u>Amendments</u>: No provision of present Contract shall be changed or modified in any way (including this provision) either in whole or in part except by an instrument in writing made after the date of this Contract and signed on behalf of both the parties and which expressly states to amend the present Contract.
