COAST GUARD EVACUATES SERIOUSLY ILL PATIENT FROM TUG

New Delhi, 27 Mar 24. In a swift midnight operation Indian Coast Guard Station Veraval evacuated a seriously ill patient (Mr. K Ponnusamy, Age - 47) from Tug ABS Anokhi 10 Kms into sea from Veraval on 26 Mar 24. On receipt of information regarding the medical emergency, ICG Interceptor Craft C-121 was sailed immediately from Veraval by ICG Maritime Rescue Sub Centre Veraval with medical team embarked onboard. ICG craft on reaching scene of action, established communication with the tug and the patient who was critically ill was swiftly and safely shifted to ICG Craft and evacuated to Govt. Hospital, Veraval for further medical management.
