FOUNDATION STONE LAYING CEREMONY DATA CENTRE SITE, MAHIPALPUR, NEW DELHI

New Delhi, 06 Nov 24: IG Anand Prakash Badola, Deputy Director General (Policy & Plans), Indian Coast Guard (ICG) laid the foundation stone for the Tier-III Data Centre of Project Digital Coast Guard (DCG) on 05 Nov 2024 at Mahipalpur, New Delhi.

Project DCG is a strategically important project for ICG, being executed by M/s TCIL. DCG Project will be a testimony of the technological advancement made by ICG. It includes construction of state-of-the-art Data Centre at Mahipalpur, New Delhi and Disaster Recovery Data Centre at New Mangalore, Karnataka, a PAN India connectivity among ICG locations including ships and implementation of an Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) application.

At its core, the DCG project has the Tier-III Data Centre equipped with the newest technology.
