### Notification

S.R.O. \_\_\_\_\_\_. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Coast Guard Upper Division Clerk and Lower Division Clerk (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2010, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Upper Division Clerk and Lower Division Clerk in Coast Guard Organization under Ministry of Defence, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement**. - (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Defence, Coast Guard Upper Division Clerk and Lower Division Clerk (Group 'C' Posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2017.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix**. - The number of said posts, their classification and the Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) <u>of the Schedule annexed to these rules</u>.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, and qualification, etc.**- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

## 4. **Disqualification.**- No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said Posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax**.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving**. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note 2: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered for promotion provided they are not short of requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service. Deputation: Officers of the Central Government holding analogous posts on regular basis; or with eight years regular service in the grade of Lower Division Clerk or equivalent in Level-2 in the Pay Matrix.
