

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (RFI) FOR OIL SPILL RESPONSE
EQUIPMENT

1. The Indian Coast Guard, Ministry of Defence, intends to procure Weir Boom in order to undertake response operations at sea.

2. This Request for Information (RFI) consists of two parts as indicated below:-

(a) Part I. The first part of the RFI incorporates operational characteristics and features that should be met by the equipment under procurement proposal. Few important technical parameters of the proposed equipment are also mentioned.

(b) Part II. The second part of the RFI states the methodology of seeking response of vendors. Submission of incomplete response format will render the vendor liable for rejection.

PART-I

3. The Intended Use of Equipment Oil spill response operation at sea.

4. Important Technical Parameters. The broad parameters of the Weir Boom is as follows:-

(a)	Weir Boom- with accessories and power pack	(i) Material – Neoprene rubber/Synthetic rubber. The fabric to provide superior resistance to abrasion, UV light. (ii) Inflation – Single point inflation (iii) Section Length (iv) Boom Weight (v) Height when inflated (vi) Freeboard (vii) Draft (viii) Buoyancy to weight ratio (ix) Ballast member (x) Hydraulic power pack with capacity (xi) Boom reel (xii) No of weir (xiii) Capacity of each weir (xiv) Accessories as per standard fittings

5. Vendors should confirm that following conditions are acceptable:-
- (a) The solicitation of offers will be as per 'Single Stage-Two Bid System'. It would imply that a 'Request for Proposal' would be issued soliciting the technical and commercial offers together, but in two separate sealed envelopes. The validity of commercial offers would be at least 12 months from the date of submitting of offers.
 - (b) The technical offers would be evaluated by a Technical Evaluation Committee (TEC) to check its compliance with RFP.
 - (c) Amongst the vendors cleared by staff evaluation, a Contract Negotiations Committee would decide the lowest cost bidder (L1) and conclude the appropriate contract.
 - (d) Vendor would be bound to provide product support for time period specified in the RFP, which includes spares and maintenance tools/jigs/fixtures for field and component level repairs.
 - (e) The vendor would be required to accept the general conditions of contract given in the Standard Conditions and Special Conditions of Contract as given in Part III and IV of Appendix 'C' of DPM 2009 placed on www.mod.nic.in
 - (f) Performance cum Warranty bonds. PB cum WB both equal to 5% value of the contract is required to be submitted after signing of contract.

6. Procedure for Response
- (a) Vendors must fill the form of response as given in Appendix 'A' or 'B' (depending upon whether the vendor is an Indian or Foreign firm) to this RFI. Apart from filling details about company, details about the exact product meeting our generic technical specifications should also be carefully filled. Details as placed at Appendix 'C' are also required to be forwarded by the vendor. Additional literature on the product can also be attached with the form.
