**PRE QUALIFICATION FOR ERDD-2018 OF ICGS ANKIT**  
**INVITATION OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST AND COMMENTS/QUERIES**

Sir,

1. It is intimated that e-mail containing following defect list serials (Hull HA- 1001 to HA-1020) in respect of **ERDD** of **ICGS Ankit** based at Porbandar for **16 days excluding days of docking and undocking** duration along with serial wise CGRHQ (NW) remarks has been forwarded to date **23 Jul 2018** :-
2. Item wise Technical comments/queries are invited for the defects remarked "DO" by CGRHQ (NW) on the defect list enclosed. **Please note that only technical comments/queries need to be forwarded and no "Budgetary Quote" is to be forwarded. Forwarding of budgetary offer will disqualify the concerned refitting yard from the tendering process.**
3. **The ERDD is to be undertaken in Gujarat/ Maharashtra/ Goa coast of India only.** The ERDD is tentatively scheduled to commence in the month of **Aug 2018** for period of **16 days excluding days of docking and undocking**. The ERDD of the ship is to start within 15 days of signing the Refit Contract. However, in case the ship is not available during this period of 15 days, the refit of the ship would deemed to have commenced with effect from the date the ship is subsequently made available for ERDD by Indian Coast Guard.
4. The conduct of ERDD including other general conditions, payment terms, etc. will be governed in accordance with provisions of Defence Procurement Manual in vogue.
5. For details of defects on machinery, systems and ship's Hull, you are requested to contact **"The District Technical Officer, CGDHQ-1, Porbandar (Tele No.0286-2248610)"** to ascertain availability of ship in harbour and clearance to visit the ship.

6. You are advised to depute your reps to the ship for meeting the Technical Officer/Executive Officer in order to assess the defect wise work package physically prior submitting technical comments/queries.

7. **In the event that firm /refitting firms does not have its own infrastructure including workshop facility at the place of refit, it should have a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with a local firm which owns at least a workshop facility befitting the refit of a ship. The refitting firm / refitting firms should be a licensee or have a MoU with a local firm who is a licensee of Port/ PSU/private refitting firm in whose dry dock the ship is going to be docked. The proof for both the facilities (workshop and drydock) is to be attached with the technical bid so as to ascertain the technical qualification of the yard.**

8. **It may be noted that RFP will be issued to all those yards who have not conveyed their unwillingness to undertake the refit in accordance with provisions of DPM.**



**SCOPE OF WORK**

<b><u>DEFECT SL.</u></b>	<b><u>DEFECT DESCRIPTION</u></b>
<b><u>YARD SERVICES/ GENERAL SERVICES</u></b>	
HA-1001	Pre and post refit trials to be carried out to assess the performance and status of water jets.
HA-1002	Carry out docking and undocking of ship. ERDD duration 16 days excluding days of docking and undocking. Any damages occurred during docking / undocking process & ERDD to be borne by ship yard. Stern clearance of 08-10 Mtrs is to be provided for removal of water jets.
HA-1003	Preparation of keel/shaped blocks to be made for the docking in Version-I only. Yard to provide weights for correcting ship's trim for docking in (even keel).
HA-1004	Tug hire charges for docking / undocking and berthing / un berthing are to be provided.
HA-1005	Pilot to be provided for all movements during docking and undocking.
HA-1006	Berthing / un-berthing at wet basin to be provided including basin charges for 04 days.
HA-1007	Fire main supply of 4-bar pressure to be supplied to ship for entire duration of ERDD.
HA-1008	Supply of fresh water to be catered for 02 tons including 250 liters drinking water (RO purified) per day. However, payment to be made for actual consumption on pro rata basis.
HA-1009	Supply of compressed air to be made available as and when required.
HA-1010	Shore supply up to 300 units to be provided including shore supply cable connection and disconnection as and when required. Payment for power to be made for actual consumption on pro rata basis.
HA-1011	Carry away pipes to be provided during dry-docking.
HA-1012	One garbage box to be provided and clearance to be done twice a day.
HA-1013	Crane (5 tonnes) to be provided as and when required for lifting and movement of water jets during dismounting/mounting and loading/unloading/transportation of water jets from ship to yards workshop. Yard to cater for a total duration of 25 hrs.

HA-1014	The refitting yard to provide one mini bus 24 seater for the duration of ERDD for 100 Km/day or 12 hrs/day whichever is exhausted earlier. The transport usage commences and terminates at the gangway of the ship/accommodation.
HA-1015	<p><b>Accommodation:</b> During the uninhabitable period, accommodation is to be provided for following crew as per the scale of accommodation indicated below:-</p> <p>(i) <u>Officers.</u> Cabin accommodation for 04 officers with following Amenities :-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(aa) One single occupancy A/C room</li> <li>(ab) 02 double occupancy A/C rooms for officers</li> <li>(ac) Attached toilet with bathroom.</li> <li>(ad) Basic room, curtain and TV.</li> <li>(ae) Table and chairs.</li> <li>(af) Basic linen viz. mattress, bed sheets, pillow, pillow covers, blankets to be provided.</li> <li>(ag) Dining space.</li> </ul> <p>(ii) <u>Subordinate Officer.</u> Cabin accommodation for 08 subordinates with following facilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(aa) 04 no air cooled double bedrooms.</li> <li>(ab) Attached toilets &amp; bathrooms.</li> <li>(ac) Basic room, curtain.</li> <li>(ad) Table and chairs.</li> <li>(ae) Basic linen viz. mattress, bed sheets, pillow, pillow covers, blankets to be provided.</li> <li>(af) Common dining space with TV</li> </ul> <p>(iii) <u>Enrolled Personnel.</u> Dormitory type accommodation with curtains for 27 enrolled personnel to be provided. The scale of accommodation is as follows: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(aa) 27 in nos. single bed/cots. Rooms to have air cooler circulator.</li> <li>(ab) Each single bed/cot to be provided with mattress, bed sheet, pillow cover.</li> <li>(ac) Six W/C and Six bathroom.</li> <li>(ad) Dormitory room to have basic upholstery like teapoy, curtains and easy chairs and wardrobe for keeping uniforms and day to days items.</li> <li>(ae) Dining space and cooking area.</li> </ul>
HA-1016	Shore galley facilities including gas burners and cost of cooking gas to be provided during period ship's galley becomes non-operational.

HA-1017	Yard to provide following services for water jet repairs. The scope also includes provision of skilled manpower and riggers (total 40 man days) while undertaking repair of water jets:-																								
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HA-1018	Water jets cleaning/washing for marine growth to be undertaken prior commencing the removal from ship.																								
HA-1019	Removal & fitment of inlet duct grating to be undertaken by yard.																								
HA-1020	Painting of water jets. (Paint Scheme: M/s Sigma Alphagen 650 Red Brown) Qty: 20 Ltrs. Paint yard supply.
