INDIAN COAST GUARD MONTHLY REPORT

INTRODUCTION

1. Indian Coast Guard came into existence in accordance with the Coast Guard Act, 1978 with the motto “वयम् रक्षामः” (Vayam Rakshamah) which translates from Sanskrit as “We Protect”. ICG’s mission is to ensure safety, security and law enforcement at sea, Search & Rescue services and Protection of the Marine Environment etc.
2. On 07 Aug 23, ADG S Paramesh, PTM, TM appointed as Additional Director General of Indian Coast Guard.
3. India is celebrating 77th year of Independence. During this "Amritkaal", Indian Coast Guard celebrated ‘**Har Ghar Tiranga**’ campaign by distributing national flags amongst fishermen, local coastal population and took pride in unfurling the Tiranga at sea to spread message of Unity and Patriotism. August is one of the core monsoon months. ICG efforts during this month have been covered in this report.

MAJOR OPERATIONS

A. Seizure of 130 Kgs Raw Cucumber from Uchipulli Sea Shore, North Mandapam (Tamil Nadu).

On 01 Aug 23, ICGS Mandapam received an intelligence input on likely transshipment of illegal contraband north of Mandapam. ICG team was deployed for surveillance. Meanwhile, ICG Mandapam RIB on patrolling was also diverted towards Uchipulli sea shore area for providing back up to the station team. On reaching the spot, the team found 06 gunny bags containing raw Sea Cucumber at the sea shore of Uchipulli Sea Shore, North Mandapam (Tamil Nadu). The Sea Cucumber was seized by the ICG team and handed over to Forest Department for further necessary action. The estimated commercial value of the consignment is approximately Rs. 57.17 Lakhs.

B. Apprehension of IFB MA Durga.

On 14 Aug 23, CGDHQ-8 received an intelligence input regarding indulgence of Indian fishing boat in smuggling activity. On 15 Aug 23, a joint operation was carried out by ICG, CISF(HDC), SIB & Customs and identified an IFB MA Durga near Brindabanchak, Sunrise point beach. On reaching the spot, the team found 590 Bags of Areca/Betel Nuts. The estimated commercial value of the consignments is approximately ₹ 309.76 Lakhs.

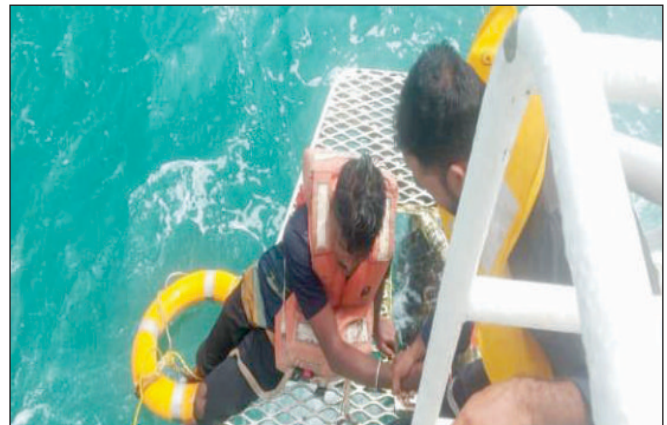
On 26 Jul 23, MRCC (Mumbai) received an email from Master of Research Vessel Sindhu Sadhana regarding request for towing assistance view vessel having propulsion failure. On receipt of information, ICGS Sujeet on area patrol was diverted for rendering assistance. Additionally, ICGS Varaha was also diverted to provide assistance to distressed vessel. In challenging and inclement weather conditions, ICGS Sujeet safely towed the distressed vessel to Mormugao harbour and saved 36 lives which included 08 scientists.

B. SAR Efforts for Man Over Board Ex-Indian Fishing Boat - B Gouri.

On 28 Jul 23, ICG Ship C-145 on area patrol sighted 03 persons floating at sea and in distress at position around 15 nm South-East of East Island, Diglipur. ICG Ship C-145 rescued all three personnel embarked onboard and provided first aid. The crew ascertained that the boat was flooded and subsequently sunk due to adverse sea. Thereafter, the ICG Ship disembarked the rescued crew at Diglipur harbour.

C. SAR Efforts for Flooding onboard Indian Fishing Boat (IFB) - Mariyam.

On 29 Jul 23, MRSC Kochi received information distress due to hull damage in IFB Mariyam with 08 crew. On receipt of the information, ICGS Arnvesh on area patrol was diverted to render necessary assistance. ICG ship Damage Control (DC) team carried out temporary repair and arrested the flooding. Thereafter, IFB was safely brought to Munambam fishing harbour Kochi (Kerala) under escort of ICG Ship.

D. Medical Evacuation of patients at Male (Maldives) by Indian Coast Guard helicopter.

On 09 Aug 23, MNDF requested for medical evacuation of a 36 years old female Maldivian national (Hawwa Abdulla). The patient was evacuated from Gan to Male for further medical management at IGM Hospital, Male. The timely assistance saved one precious life.

E. Medical Emergency onboard MV Evelyn Maersk.

On 13 Aug 23, MRSC, Vizhinjam received a call from Denmark flagged MV Evelyn Maersk regarding medical emergency onboard. A 55 years old Filipino patient (Mr. Gilbert) was reported unconscious and having difficulty in breathing (probable cardiac arrest). On receipt of the information, ICG Ship C-427 was deployed for medical evacuation and evacuated the patient safely . The ship entered Vizhinjam harbour along with the patient at 2345 h on 13 Aug 23. Thereafter, the patient was handed over to local agent for further medical management at NIMS Hospital, Trivandrum.

F. Medical Evacuation of patients at Male (Maldives) by Indian Coast Guard helicopter.

On 13 Aug 23, MNDF requested for medical evacuation of a 44 years old Maldivian national (Mr. Hassan Seed) diagnosed with decompression sickness requiring treatment by medical specialist. The patient was evacuated from Kooddoo to Male for further medical management at IGM Hospital, Male. The timely assistance saved one precious life.

G. Medical Emergency onboard MV Dong Fang Kan Tan No.2.

On 16 Aug 23, MRCC Mumbai received information regarding medical emergency onboard Panama flagged MV Dong Fang Kan Tan No. 2 in position 124 N miles South-West of Prongs Lt, Mumbai. 24 years old Chinese national (Mr. Yin Weignyang) was reported suffering from chest pain/ symptoms of cardiac arrest and requested urgent evacuation. Considering the criticality of the patient ICG ALH Mk-III from CGAE Porbandar was launched staging through CGAS Daman. ICG Ship Samrat on area patrol was diverted to support evacuation through ICG ALH considering the prevalent weather conditions. Further, CG ALH evacuated the patient from the vessel at 0145 h and landed Daman at 0255 h on 17 Aug 23. The patient was safely handed over to medical team arranged by local agent for further clearance / medical management.

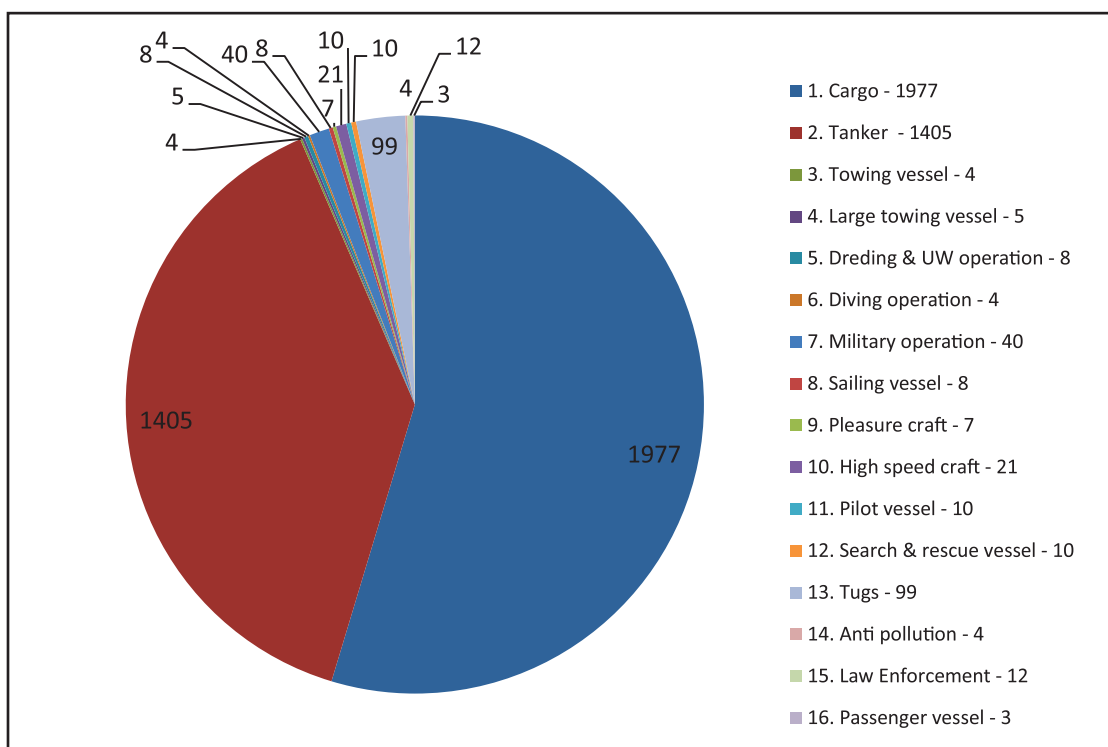

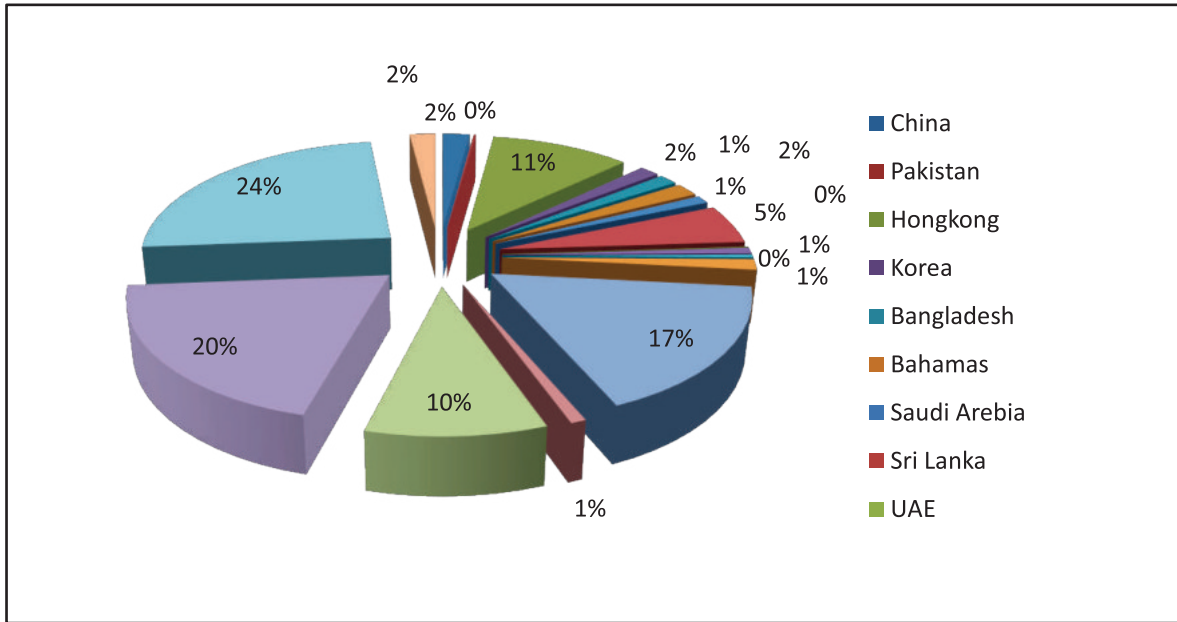

Traffic pattern in AoR based on type of specific vessels

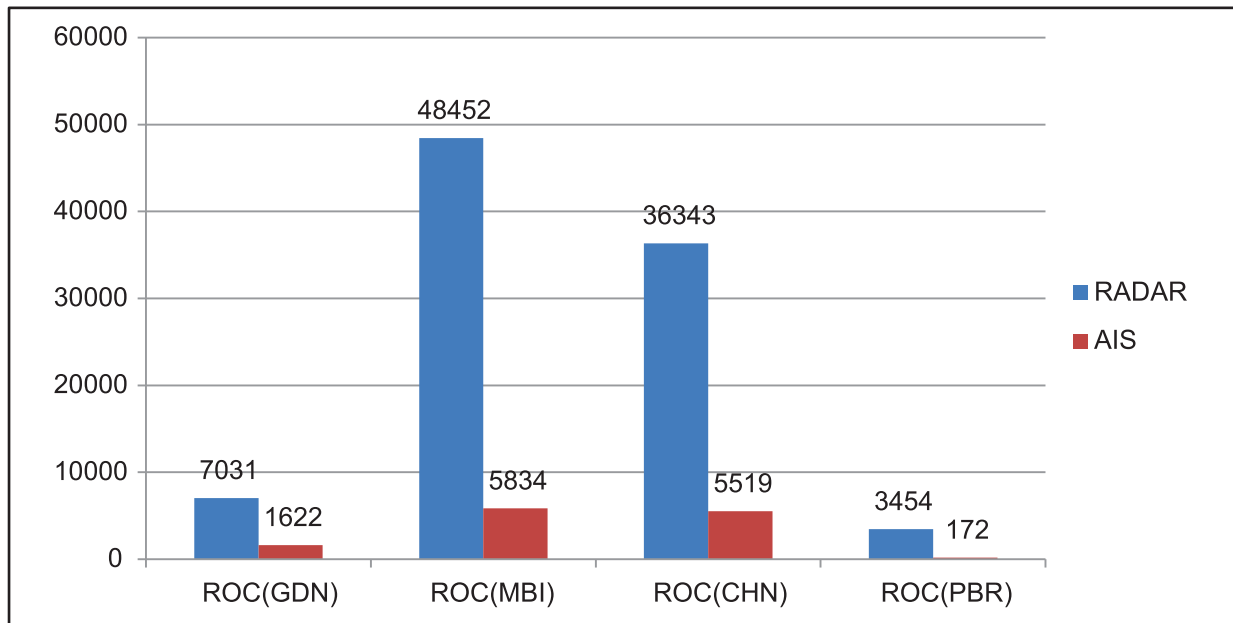

Coast Guard rescues NIO vessel off Karwar coast

The Indian Coast Guard on Thursday averted a potential environmental disaster as it rescued the research ship of the National Institute of Oceanography (NIO), *RV Sindhu Sadhana*, that suffered engine failure and was drifting close to Karwar, with 36 people onboard, including eight scientists. The vessel was drifting at a speed of 0.3 knots and was approximately 20 nautical miles from the land, the Coast Guard said in a statement. "The situation was critical as the NIO was carrying valuable scientific equipment and research data. Moreover, the proximity of the ship to the ecologically sensitive Karwar coastline posed an imminent threat of grounding, which

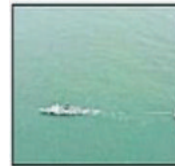
कोस्ट गार्ड ने जहाज में फंसे आठ वैज्ञानिकों, 36 कू सदस्यों को बचाया
