INDIAN COAST GUARD MONTHLY REPORT

INTRODUCTION

1. Indian Coast Guard came into existence in accordance with the Coast Guard Act, 1978 with the motto “वयम् रक्षामः” (Vayam Rakshamah) which translates from Sanskrit as “We Protect”. ICG’S mission is to ensure safety, security and law enforcement at sea, Search & Rescue services and Protection of the Marine Environment etc.

2. In the month of Nov 23, ICG conducted 9th National Pollution Response Exercise (NATPOLREX) at Vadinar, Gujarat from 23-25 Nov 23. In this event, 33 international observers from 24 Friendly Foreign Countries (FFCs) and 02 International Agencies participated. Further, under aegis of Colombo Security Conclave, a two day workshop on Marine Pollution Response was also conducted at Mumbai from 26-27 Nov 23. In addition assistance to stranded/disabled Indian fishing boat, medical evacuation was undertaken by Indian Coast Guard. The details of these activities undertaken by ICG have been summarised in this report.

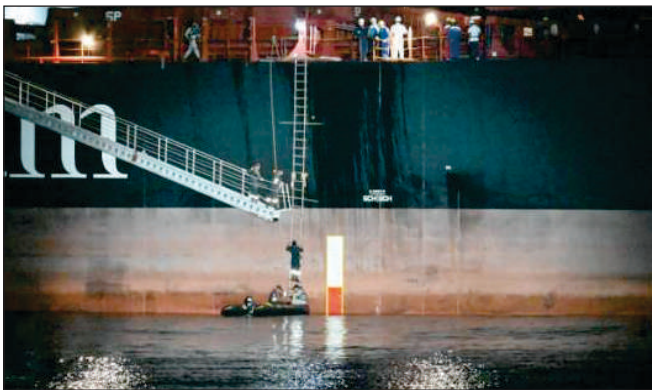


A. Towing Assistance to Stranded IFB Mageswari.

On 04 Nov 23, Master of Stranded IFB Mageswari requested Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre (MRCC), Chennai for Towing assistance view engine failure. ICGS C-440 was deployed to render assistance. The ship reach datum and safely took distressed IFB under tow and brought to Kasimedu fishing harbour, Chennai. All 07 crew were reported to be safe.

B. Medical Emergency onboard MV Rostrum Cynic.

On 11 Nov 23, MV Rostrum Cynic requested Indian Coast Guard Station (ICGS), Hutbay for medical evacuation of a 47 years old Filipino national (Mr. Sangcap Avelino Jr.) suspected with Spinal Cord Injuries and broken left hand. ICGS Rajkiran was diverted to evacuate the patient. ICGS Rajkiran embarked the patient onboard and brought to Port Blair. The patient was transferred to GB Pant Hospital, Port Blair for further medical management.

C. Towing Assistance to Disabled IFB Sorayya.

On 20 Nov 23, a stranded IFB Sorayya (IND-AN-SA-MM-997) with 06 crew was drifting at 230 East Island Lt 40 due to engine failure and requested MRSC Diglipur for assistance. ICGS Aruna Asaf Ali in area patrol was diverted to render assistance. ICG Ship reached the datum and launched her boarding party. The boat was taken under tow by ICGS Aruna Asaf Ali and brought to Diglipur Harbour. The stranded IFB alongwith 06 crew was handed over to fisheries department.

D. Medical Emergency onboard Indian Fishing Board (IFB) Asht Vinayak.

On 22 Nov 23, Indian Fishing Boat (IFB) Asht Vinayak requested Maritime Rescue Sub Centre (MRSC), Pipavav for medical emergency onboard IFB asht Vinayak. ICG C-409 embarked with Medical Officer evacuated the patient. The injured fishermen admitted at Civil Hospital, Hanumanta, Mahuva for further medical management.

E. Assistance to Disabled Indian Fishing Board (IFB) Adonai.

On 22 Nov 23, a drifting IFB Adonai due to engine failure alongwith 13 crew onboard in position 18 N miles South of Keating Point, Andaman & Nicobar, requested immediate assistance from MRCC Port Blair. ICG Ship Vishwast on area patrol was diverted towards adrift boat to render assistance. The ICG Ship arrived datum and technical team of ICG Ship boarded the IFB. However, efforts for defect rectification proved futile. Consequently, ICG Ship brought the boat to Carnic anchorage (Sawai Bay) under tow. The timely assistance of ICG save 13 precious lives.

F. Rescue of Bangladeshi fishermen

On 23 Nov 23, Indian Coast Guard Dornier ex- Coast Guard Air Enclave (CGAE), Kolkata during routine patrol assisted in rescue of one Bangladeshi national by Indian Fishing Boat (IFB) Narendra-II. The survivor was from sunken Bangladeshi fishing boat that was capsized during cyclone 'Midhili'. On receipt of information, ICGS Anmol recovered the fishermen from IFB Narendra-II. Further, ICGS Varad handed over the fishermen to BCG Ship Shadhin Bangla off IMBL in accordance with existing SOPs and MoU.

G. Assitance to Disabled IFB Harishima.

On 24 Nov 23, an adrift IFB Harishima due to wheel pump failure requested Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre (MRCC), Port Blair for towing assistance. ICG Ship C-412 was deployed from Hutbay to render assistance. ICG ship arrived datum and took IFB under tow and brought to Hutbay. The IFB was handed over to the local fisheries department safely.

A. 9th National Pollution Response Exercise (NATPOLREX).

The 9th NATPOLREX with participation of 33 international observers from 24 FFCs and 02 International Agencies was conducted at Vadinar, Gujarat from 23-25 Nov 23. The exercise was conducted as a three-day event encompassing participants' arrival, Ice-Breaking Ceremony on the first day, Workshop and Table Top Exercises on Pollution Response including case studies on major marine oil and chemical spill incidents on the second day and Sea Exercise on final day.

B. ICG Participation in Expert Group Meeting (EGM).

United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) under the auspices of the Global Maritime Crime Programme (GMCP) and the Global Programme on Implementing the Organized Crime Convention had conducted a hybrid Expert Group Meeting from 20-23 Nov 23 in Vienna, Australia. The EGM envisaged reviewing UNODC's legislative guide on combating Pollution Crime and its annex on the pollution of the Marine Environment. Further, one ICG Officer attended the EGM through virtual mode.

C. Colombo Security Conclave (CSC) - Marine Pollution Response Workshop.

On completion of the 9th NATPOLREX at Vadinar, a two-day workshop on Marine Pollution Response was conducted at Mumbai from 26-27 Nov 23 under the aegis of Colombo Security Conclave. The workshop witnessed participation from all five CSC Nations wherein brainstorming sessions/ discussions on the emerging trend of marine pollution response was undertaken. Further, the workshop also entailed the participants with hands-on experience of various pollution response equipment held at Coast Guard Pollution Response Team, Mumbai.

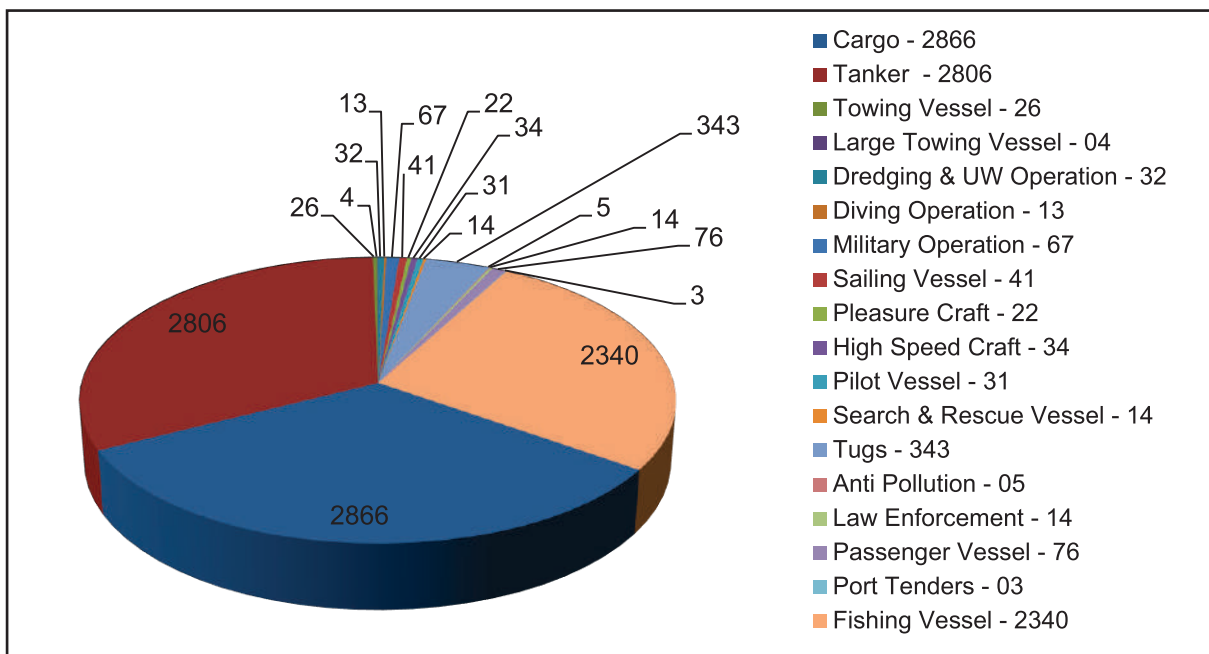
A. Coastal Security Exercise and Operations.

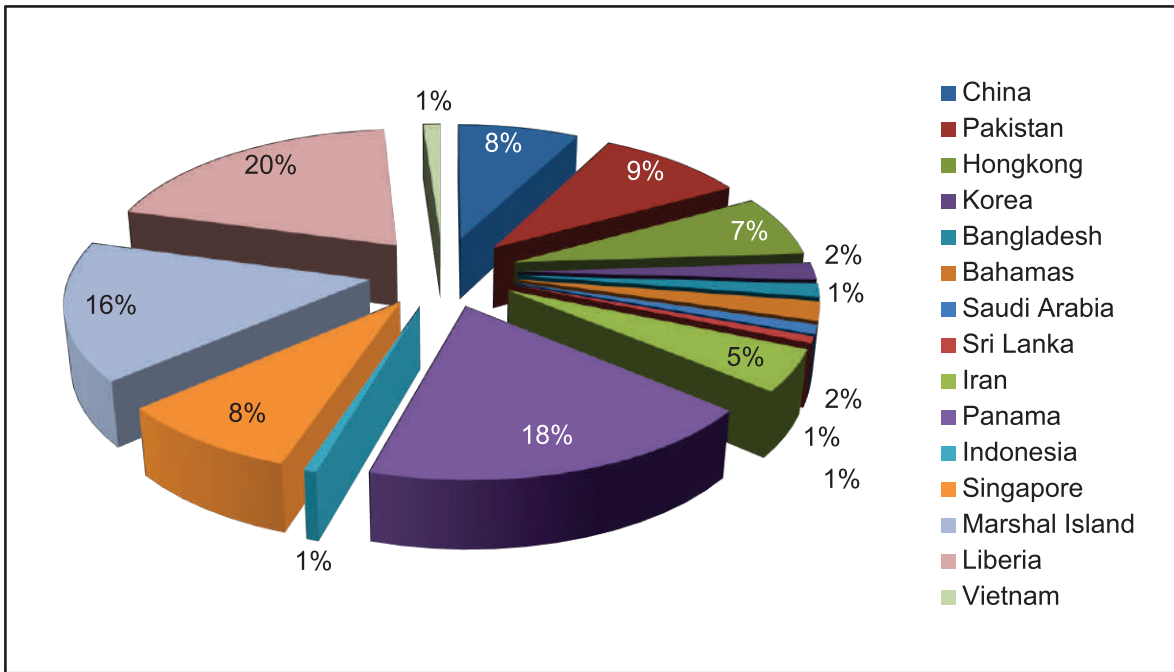


Fig : Vessels operating in AoR based on flag

Number of Ships and Crafts identified at ROCs – Oct 23

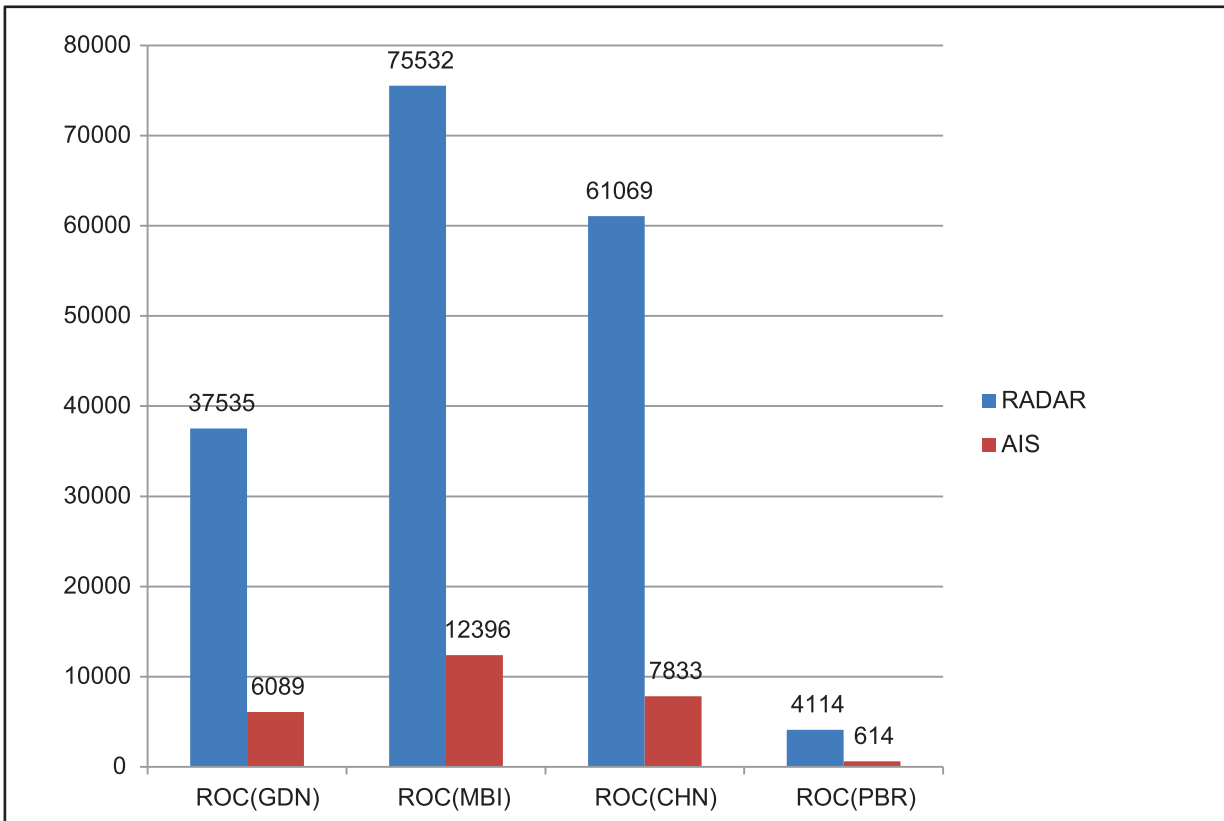


Fig : Targets detected at Remote Operating Centers in Oct 23

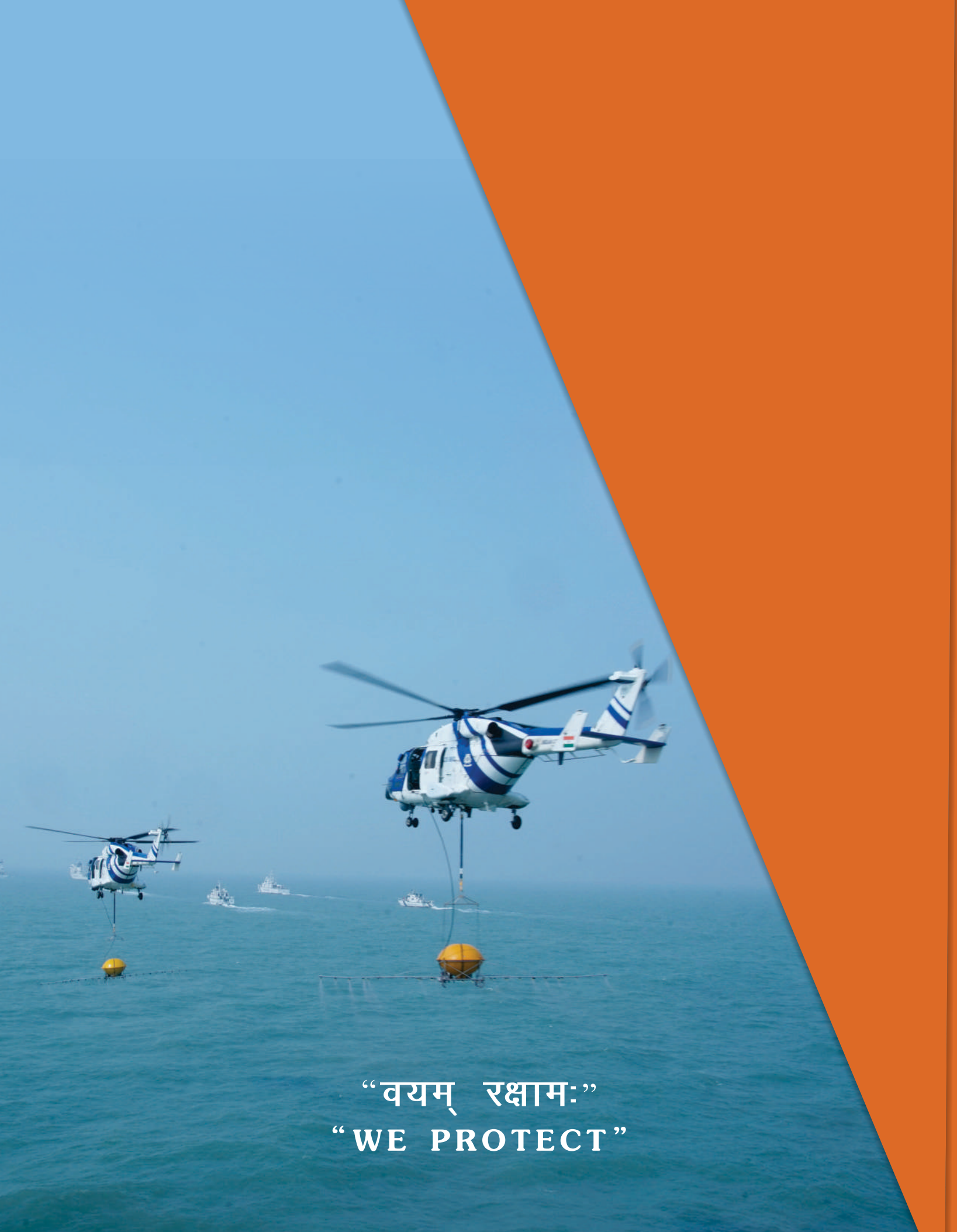
