INDIAN COAST GUARD MONTHLY REPORT

INTRODUCTION

1. Indian Coast Guard came into existence in accordance with the Coast Guard Act, 1978 with the motto “वयम् रक्षामः” (Vayam Rakshamah) which translates from Sanskrit as “We Protect”. ICG’s mission is to ensure safety, security and law enforcement at sea, Search & Rescue services and Protection of the Marine Environment etc.
2. In Dec 23, Indian Coast Guard Ship and Aircraft ensured ‘Zero Casualty at Sea’ with proactive stance during cyclone ‘Michaung’. Indian Coast Guard Disaster Response Team was also deployed to mitigate and alleviate the suffering of stranded persons in Chennai.
3. Indian Coast Guard in collaboration with ReCAAP ISC conducted a four day (11-15 Dec 23) event i.e. Capacity Building Senior Officer Meeting (CBSOM) - 2023 wherein 19 international delegates and national experts participated in the meeting. The objective of the meeting was to understand the updated situation of maritime piracy and armed robbery against ships in Asia,

MAJOR OPERATIONS

A. Seizure of PREGAB 150 mg Capsules off Gulf of Mannar.

On 12 Dec 23, ICGS Mandapam received an intelligence input on likely transshipment of illegal contraband. ICG team was deployed for surveillance. During the operation, ICG team seized 13 Cardboard boxes from IFB IND-TN-10-MO-2796. The whole consignment was confiscated and taken to ICGS Mandapam. All the 13 cardboard boxes were opened and found containing 6,66,000 (Six Lakh Sixty Six Thousand) capsules of PREGAB 150 mg. The whole consignment was handed over to Customs department for further legal action. **The commercial value of the consignment is approximately ₹ 66.60 Lakhs.**

SEARCH & RESCUE

A. Assistance to Distressed Indian Fishing Boat (IFB) Sarah Puthin.

On 04 Dec 23, ICGS Samudra Paheredar received VHF call from IFB Sarah Puthin regarding flooding onboard in North West of Kadalur, Kerala. On receipt of information, ICG Ship Samudra Paheredar launched Ship's boarding party alongwith Ship's divers for assessment of flooding onboard distressed IFB and thereafter, flooding was arrested using Damage Control material and equipment. Further, ICG Ship C-404 escorted IFB Sarah Puthin to Baypore Harbour safely.

B. Medical Emergency onboard Merchant Vessel (MV) Anna Schulte.

On 09 Dec 23, M/s Interocean Shipping Pvt Ltd requested Maritime Rescue Sub Centre (MRSC) Mundra for medical evacuation of a Ghana national patient onboard MV Anna Schulte (Flag-Singapore) off Mundra, Gujarat. The patient was reported to have sustained finger / palm injury wherein the right hand little finger was totally severed and palm and index finger were badly injured and thus merited urgent medical evacuation. ICGS C-403 was immediately deployed from Mundra harbour. ICG Ship embarked the patient onboard and brought to Mundra. The patient was transferred to Adani Hospital, Mundra for further medical management.

C. Medical Emergency onboard Merchant Vessel (MV) Green K-MAX-2.

On 14 Dec 23, MV Green K-Max-2 (Flag-Liberia) requested Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre (MRCC) Chennai for medical evacuation of a 29 years old Philippine national patient onboard in position 15 N miles North-East of Vishakhapatnam. The patient was reported to have sustained leg injury (fracture on limb). Indian Coast Guard Ship C-451 was deployed for evacuation. ICG medical team provided initial medical aid and ICGS C-451 embarked the patient onboard and brought to Vishakhapatnam harbour and handed over to local shipping agent for further medical management.

D. Medical Emergency onboard Merchant Vessel (MV) Bluk Lambert.

On 16 Dec 23, MV Bulk Lambert requested Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre (MRCC) Chennai for medical evacuation of a Philippine national (Mr. Abunales Glenn) onboard in position 50 N miles south of Vishakhapatnam. The patient was reported to have sustained fracture on his hand and thus merited urgent medical evacuation. Indian Coast Guard Ship C-451 was deployed to evacuate the patient. ICGS C-451 embarked the patient onboard and brought to Vishakhapatnam harbour and handed over the patient to local shipping agent for further medical management.

E. Aid to Civil Authority- Flood Situation in Tuticorin & Tirunelveli.

Due to cyclonic circulation in south Bay of Bengal off Sri Lanka, Southern District of Tamil Nadu received unprecedented rainfall from 17-18 Dec 23 which caused flood like situation in Tirunelveli and Thoothukudi districts alongwith extremely heavy rainfall in these areas. Due to incessant rain and floods, Tamil Nadu State administration sought assistance of ICG for rescue efforts and supply of food, medicine and other disaster relief activities. Indian Coast Guard swiftly mobilised necessary surface/ air assets, Disaster Relief Teams (DRTs), equipment and material for providing rescue and relief assistance in the flood affected areas. ICGS Sujay with integral helicopter was deployed from Chennai to undertake ship-borne SAR/ relief services in flood affected areas. 05 ICG Aircraft undertook detached operations from Madurai for undertaking speedy relief operations. 08 DRTs along with food material and first aid kits were deployed in affected areas. The DRTs evacuated 758 stranded citizens from inundated areas which included pregnant ladies, elderly person/ senior citizen, paralyzed kids and district administration officials. 7020 Kgs of food material including 1700 food packets were distributed in flood affected areas.

Indian Coast Guard in collaboration with ReCAAP ISC organized a four day (11-15 Dec 23) event i.e. 15th Capacity Building Senior Officer Meeting (CBSOM) -2023 at Gandhinagar. The objective of the meeting was to understand the updated situation of maritime piracy and armed robbery against ships in Asia, exchange each others' experiences and evolve best practices to tackle such incidents with a collaborative approach from all the contracting parties. A total of 19 international delegates from 15 countries participated the meeting. In addition, senior officials from the national stakeholders such as Indian Navy, major ports, State Maritime Boards, Directorate General of Shipping and other maritime organizations also participated in this meeting.

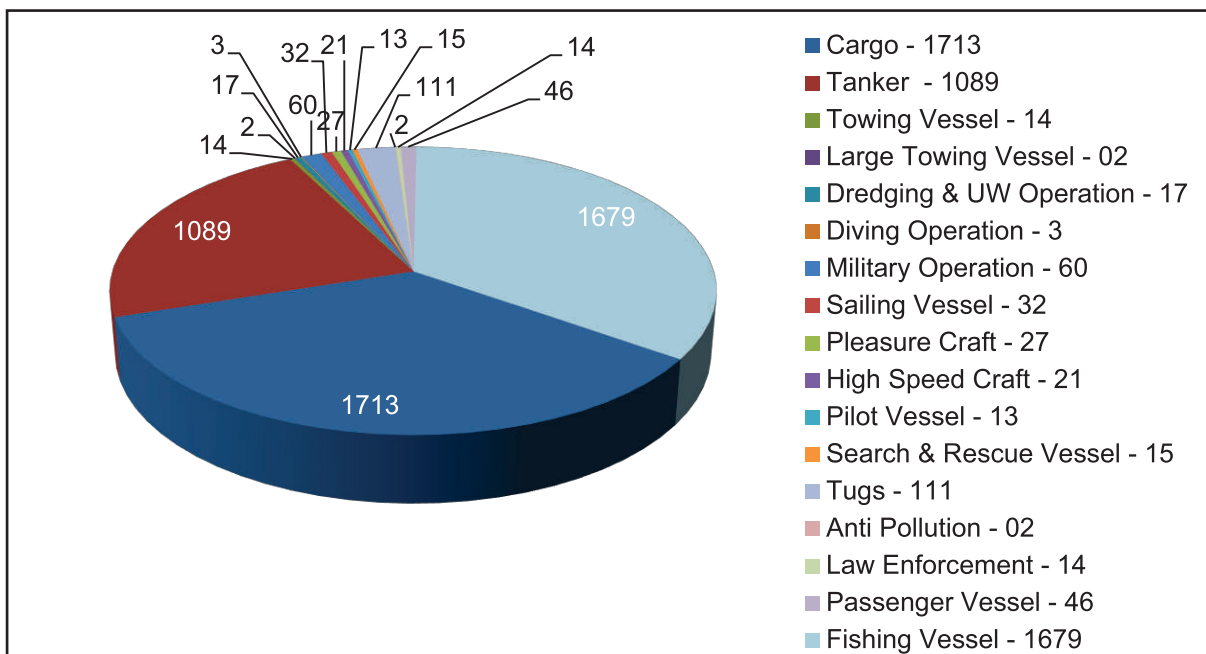

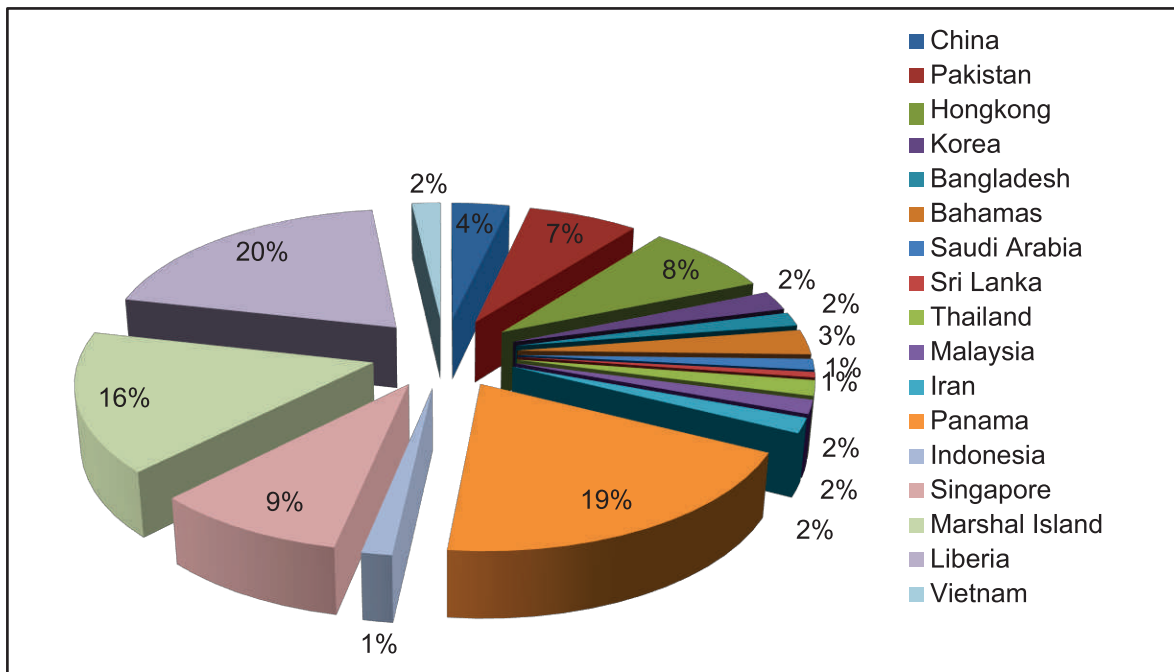


Fig : Vessels operating in AoR based on flag

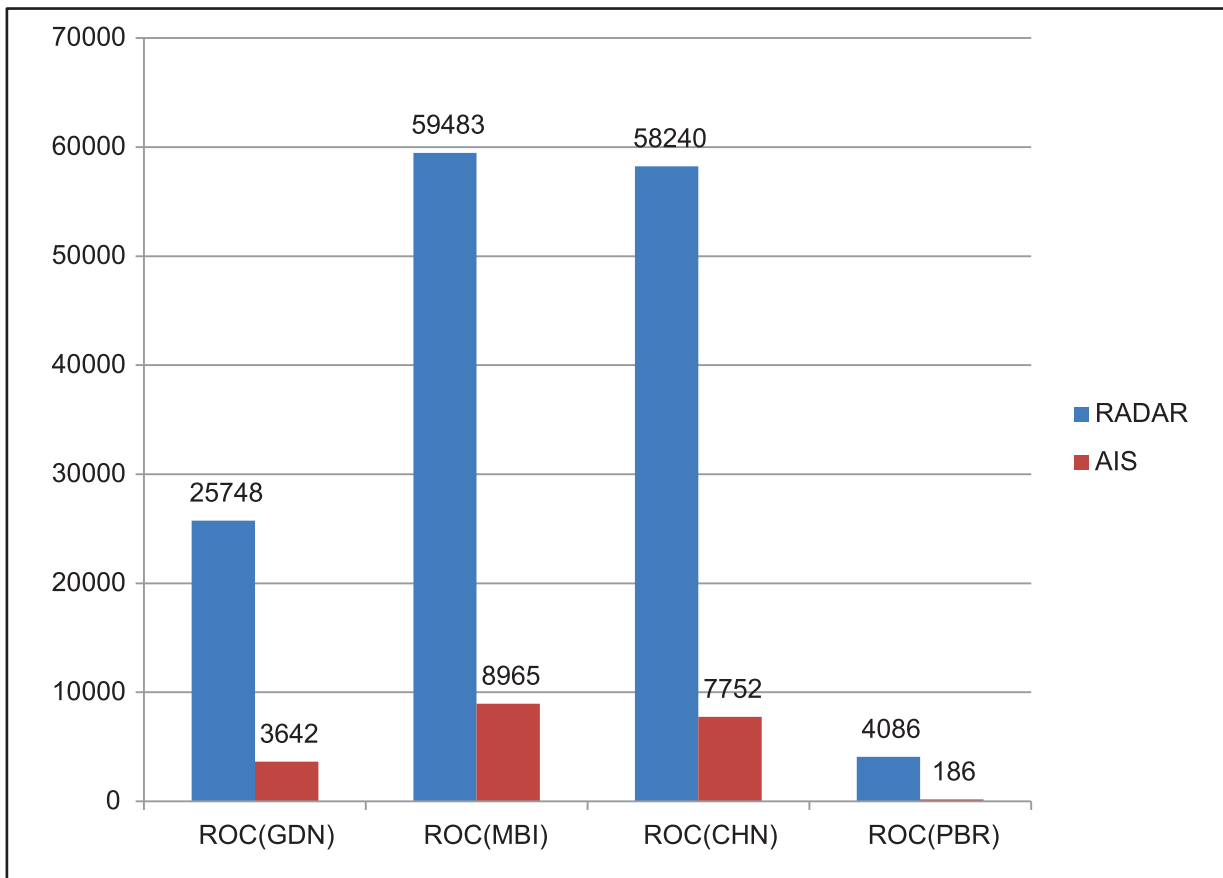


Fig : Targets detected at Remote Operating Centers in Dec 23

Coast Guard conducts pollution response exercise

THE Indian Coast Guard (ICG), along with other oil pollution response agencies, has conducted a National-level Pollution Response Exercise (NATPOLREX-IX), the Ministry of Defence said on Sunday.

"The NATPOLREX-IX accomplished its objective of testing the level of preparedness and coordination between various resource agencies to respond to a marine oil spill, invoking provisions of the National Oil Spill Disaster Contingency Plan (NOSDCP)," the ministry said.

More than 31 foreign observers and 60 delegates participated in the ninth edition of the exercise, conducted on November 25, 2023, off Vadinar coast of Gujarat.

"DG Rakesh Pal, director general of Indian Coast Guard and the chairman NOSDCP, reviewed the preparedness of all agencies during the exercise. Representatives of various ministries and departments of Central and coastal state governments, ports, oil-handling agencies and other stakeholders participated in the exercise," said the MoD.

The ICG deployed surface as well as air platforms, including pollution response vessels, offshore patrol vessels, indigenous advanced light helicopter Mi-17, and Dornier aircraft configured for marine pollution response.

'Oil spill from accidents persists despite readiness'
About 75 per cent of India's energy requirements are met by oil that is imported to our country by sea. Oil transportation by ships is fraught with inherent risks and requires preventive measures to be taken, both by the ship owners as well as the oil receiving facilities inside the port. But the threat of oil pollution persists, the defence ministry said.

The event also showcased India's industrial process in terms of the 'Make in India' thrust. The stakeholders like major ports also deployed their maritime assets for showcasing synergised efforts in combating marine pollution.

As the central coordinating authority for response to oil spills in Indian waters, Indian Coast Guard assumed responsibilities for protecting the marine environment in the maritime zones of India on March 7, 1986, when these responsibilities were transferred from the Ministry of Shipping. And subsequently, the coast guard prepared the NOSDCP for combating oil spill disasters at sea, which was approved by the Committee of Secretaries in 1993. Apart from drawing up the NOSDCP, the coast guard has established four pollution response centers at Mumbai, Chennai, Port Blair and Vadinar.

Calling for a robust national system for oil spill response as critical to India's preparedness in Indian waters, the MoD said, "Indeed, 75 per cent of India's energy requirements are met by oil that is imported to our country by sea. Oil transportation by ships is fraught with inherent risks and requires preventive measures to be taken, both by the ship owners as well as the oil receiving facilities inside the port. But the threat of oil pollution through maritime accidents and unforeseen perils of sea persists."

THE Ministry of Defence on Wednesday signed a contract with Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Ltd (MDL) in Mumbai for procurement of six next generation offshore patrol vessels for the Indian Coast Guard. The contract was made under the Buy (Indian-IDD) (Indigenously designed, developed and manufactured) category at a total cost of ₹1,614.89 crore. Out of the six vessels being procured, four would replace the existing aging offshore patrol vessels and the other two would augment the Indian Coast Guard fleet, the defence ministry said in a statement. The acquisition of these patrol vessels is aimed at boosting the Indian Coast Guard's capability and reinforcing the government's focus on maritime security, the statement said. At present, it comprises 184 surface ships.
