MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed at Coast Guard Headquarters, New Delhi on this 27th Day of May 2025.

BY AND BETWEEN

- 1. Indian Coast Guard, an Armed Force having its mailing address at Coast Guard Headquarters, National Stadium, New Delhi-110001 (First Party)
- 2. The Coast Guard Welfare & Wellness Association (CGWWA), also known as 'Tatrakshika'. CGWWA refers to the Indian Coast Guard's gender-neutral 'welfare and Wellness' association, which is set up, run and managed by the spouses of the Indian Coast Gurd personnel and has its HQ at Coast Guard Headquarters, National Stadium Complex, New Delhi 110001. (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party").

AND

- 3. **Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KIIT)**, a 'Deemed to be University' located at KIIT Road, Patia, Bhubaneswar- 751024, Odisha (hereinafter referred to as "**Third Party**").
- 4. ICG, CGWWA and KIIT are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

<u>Purpose</u>

- 5. With a view to encourage defence manufacturing, indigenisation and innovation in the country in keeping with Government's articulated vision of ATMANIRBHAR BHARAT and 'Make in India', ICG, CGWWA and KIIT (hereinafter referred to jointly as "Parties" and individually as 'party') enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).
- 6. The Parties are desirous of collaborating with each other for the education of serving/retired personnel and wards of ICG personnel including personnel deceased while in service.
- 7. The Parties hereto have agreed to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding on the terms and conditions given in the succeeding paragraphs.
- 8. Responsibilities of First Party.
 - (a) To facilitate admission in the courses by a predefined date by way of informing all the prospective schools, all ranks and other institutions of Indian Coast Guard.
 - (b) Designate an officer as a one-point contact for representing all policy and administrative issues and to clear names of prospective students on the basis of criteria as decided by the Indian Coast Guard.
 - (c) To maintain communication with the KIIT.

9. Responsibilities of Third Party.

(a) Designate a senior official as a one-point contact representing all policy administrative issues.

- (b) Acknowledge Indian Coast Guard as lead partner for the project
- (c) Undertake admission of serving/retired ICG personnel and their wards including personnel deceased while in service in consultation with first party.

Details of the scheme(s) for ICG personnel and their wards

- 10. KIIT will provide the following for ICG personnel and their wards: -
 - (a) Following scholarships/ concessions/ relaxations would be offered for serving/retired ICG personnel and their wards:
 - (i) Earmarking of <u>02 seats</u> into the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS), <u>05 Seats</u> into Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS), <u>05 Seats</u> into Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.Sc) with a scholarship in fees to an extent of <u>10%</u>. The scholarship is applicable only to the institutional fees.
 - (ii) Earmarking of <u>04 seats</u> into Bachelor of Technology (B. Tech) in Computer Science & allied programmes and any number of seats into all the other programmes offered by KIIT except Medical wing with a scholarship in fees to an extent of <u>50%</u>. The scholarship is applicable only to the institutional fees.
 - (b) The officer/ ward must fulfil NEET criteria for admission into Medical and Dental science programme. For admission into all other programmes, the officer/ ward must fulfil KIIT Entrance Examination (KIITEE) criteria.
 - (c) <u>ICG Outreach Activities at KIIT</u>: Feasibility to conduct ICG Outreach activities at KIIT to enhance awareness among the students about maritime affair, Indian Coast Guard and its roles and career opportunities in Indian Coast Guard may be considered.
- 11. <u>Obligation of First Party</u>: Provide list of candidates, to be considered for concession in, fees for admission to various programmes within the prescribed time to avoid any delay in admissions.
- 12. Resolution of Differences: In case any dispute/ claim arises between the parties w.r.t the MOU, including academic cooperation, validity, interpretation, implementation or alleged breach of any of its provisions or regarding a question, the parties hereto shall endeavor to settle such dispute amicably through bilateral discussions/ mutual negotiations between the senior officers of both the parties, who will undertake "genuine and good faith settlement" to resolve the dispute.
- 13. <u>Amendment to the MoU</u>. During the operation of the MOU circumstances if any arise which calls for modification(s) / alteration(s), they will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing.
- 14. <u>Tenure & Termination</u>. This MoU will come into effect from the date on which both parties have signed the MoU and will remain in force for an initial period of three years from then onwards. This MoU may be terminated by the either of the parties with a written notice of 3 months to the other party. In case of termination of MoU, all the activities undertaken on its basis shall be fully implemented under the same conditions as they have been started.

- 15. <u>Notices</u>. Any notice required to be given under the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) shall be in writing and delivery to the 'parties' at the addresses given herein below: -
